



Winery Deurić is located on sunny southern slopes of Fruska Gora, at an altitude of 250 meters above the sea level, in a place called Mala Remeta, near Vrdnik spa. Fruska gora has always had a great potential and an important role in Serbian viticulture, and in recent years it started to receive great importance as one of the most important wine tourism destinations in the region.

Exceptional location and the characteristics of the nature, especially the southeastern slopes of Fruska Gora, have long been known and used (for wine growing). According to historical sources, even the Roman Emperor Marcus Aurelius Probus, in the third century AD planted the first vineyards just in its south-eastern slopes in the zone of the former Sirmium. Slavs also reported continued cultivation of vines, and Serbian medieval monasteries whose Metos were the backbone of storage and duration of viticulture, winemaking and wine had particularly contributed to the continuity.

Vineyards of Deurić winery spread on 14 hectares. The natural reserve of linden trees, clean air, springs, lakes and wood land, which is surrounding these vineyards, is the basis for the production of quality wines. In the newly built winery, we are using only grapes from our own vineyards to produce wines of superior quality with the expert consultation of eminent team of oenologists from France.
